The Income Guidelines will be published each year at [www.goodshepherdscholarship.com](http://www.goodshepherdscholarship.com) and are set to be 200% of the Federal Poverty Level.

The Adjusted Gross Income (AGI) from your Tax Form is used for the Income Guidelines. You will need to submit copies of your Tax Form and supporting documentation, such as W-2 Forms.

# FAMILY TUITION CAP SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

**No income guidelines, all families are eligible to apply.** Any family may apply for a Family Tuition Cap Scholarship in all Lincoln Diocese Catholic Schools, regardless of income level. A maximum of three students from a family will be charged tuition; all other students are eligible for a full tuition scholarship, even if students are in multiple Diocesan schools. **Families must apply through FACTS for the Family Tuition Cap Scholarship.**

## ADDITIONAL SCHOLARSHIPS & FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

In addition to the Good Shepherd Scholarship Fund and the Family Tuition Cap Scholarship, Hastings Catholic Schools also has funds set aside for scholarship. Funds for the HCS Scholarship were made available through the supporting donor community.
